

DOMINE – ORGANIZACIJA ZA PROMICANJE ŽENSKIH PRAVA

*Kriza izazvana Covidom-19 rezultirala je pandemijom u sjeni, koja je u najvećoj mjeri pogodila žene. U vrijeme trajanja mjera izolacije savjetovanište bilježi porast nasilja od 75% u odnosu na isto razdoblje prošle godine, što odgovara svjetskim trendovima. Žene ostaju bez posla i na ulici, bez krova na glavom. Telefon udruge u vrijeme krize bio je dostupan 24 sata te je upućen apel za pomoć ženama žrtvama nasilja u korona krizi. Tako su Domine zapravo postale krizni centar za privremeni smještaj i pomoć ženama i žrtvama nasilja u obitelji. Žene su smještane u prazne apartmane i stanove koje su građani ustupili na korištenje. Trend se nastavio u jesen te su od sredine rujna privremeno smještene 2 žene na 8 dana, osigurano je 8 paketa financijske i materijalne pomoći, a 7 zahtjeva je u obradi. Iskustvo krize pokazalo je da nedostaje socijalna usluga privremenog smještaja u kriznom centru, te da nije razvijena praksa korištenja javnog stambenog fonda za trajni smještaj žena žrtava nasilja. Nadalje, uočen je trend rasta rizika od siromaštva žena žrtava nasilja što posebno zabrinjava s obzirom na nadolazeće razdoblje zime.*

*Cilj je projekta ojačati zagovaračku poziciju Domina prema institucijama lokalne samouprave u području prevencije i zaštite žena žrtava nasilja i žrtava nasilja u obitelji, a imajući u vidu donošenje proračuna za slijedeću godinu te predstojeće lokalne izbore u 2012.*

*To će se ostvariti terenskim istraživanjem, tj. mapiranjem potreba žena žrtava nasilja pogođenih krizom; pisanjem tematskog izvještaja o provedenom istraživanju; korištenjem zaključaka i prikupljenih iskustava žena u zagovaračkoj kampanji za stavljanje u funkciju javnog stambenog fonda namijenjenog ženama koje su preživjele nasilje i za otvaranje prvog kriznog centra za žene žrtve nasilja na području Hrvatske.*

*Korisnici, odnosno ciljane skupine su JLS, Grad Split Povjerenstvo za ravnopravnost spolova, žene te druge žrtve nasilja u obitelji.*

DOMINE – ORGANIZATION FOR PROMOTION OF WOMEN'S RIGHTS

*The crisis caused by Covid-19 resulted in a shadow pandemic, which hit women the hardest. During the isolation measures, the Counseling center recorded 75% increase in violence compared to the same period last year, which*

*corresponds to world trends. Women are left without work, roof over their head and out on the street. During that period organization's telephone was available 24/7, and public appeal was made to help women victims of violence. That way, Domine became a crisis center for temporary accommodation and help to women and victims of domestic violence. Women stayed in empty apartments provided by citizens. The trend continued in the fall and since mid-September, 2 women have been temporarily accommodated for 8 days, 8 packages of financial and material help have been provided, and 7 applications are being processed. The experience of the crisis has shown that there is a lack of social services of temporary accommodation in the crisis center, and that the practice of using public housing for permanent accommodation of women victims of violence hasn't been developed. Also, there's a growing trend of risk of poverty for women victims of violence which is particularly worrying given the coming winter.*

*The goal is to strengthen Domine's advocacy position towards local government in the field of prevention and protection of women victims of violence and victims of domestic violence, having in mind the adoption of the budget for next year and the local elections in 2021. This will be achieved through field research (mapping the needs of women victims of violence affected by the crisis); by writing a research report and using the conclusions and experiences of women in the advocacy campaign for the creating a public housing fund for women survivors of violence and for the opening of the first crisis center for women victims of violence in Croatia.*

*Target groups are local government, Split Commission for Gender Equality, women and other victims of domestic violence.*
