On 12th of December 2023 the European Commission adopted the Defence of Democracy package (DoD), ahead of the 2024 European elections.

The central piece of this package is, a foreign funding directive, aimed at **enhancing transparency** and democratic accountability of interest representation services and activities on behalf of third countries to influence the "development, formulation or implementation of policy or legislation or public decision-making in the internal market.

It also includes two recommendations which aim to promote free, fair and resilient elections and the participation of citizens and civil society organisations to policy-making.

The aim of this package is to tackle the threat of foreign interference with more transparency, while at the same time encouraging civic engagement and citizens' participation in our democracies. Here is what media wrote about DoD so far: Politico, Reuters.
