### **Event Description**

The ACF Estonia (Open Estonian Foundation) is organizing a two-day event that will combine the Active Citizens Fund's regional gathering for project promoters and fund operators from ACF countries with ACF Estonia's project promoter, the Estonian Opinion Festival. The Opinion Festival aims to revitalize democracy by strengthening the connection between the political system and citizens, fostering spaces for dialogue and participation. This inclusive event features discussions and ideas across various stages, representing nearly all societal layers and worldviews. Similar events in other countries are often called "democracy festivals" due to their goal of encouraging genuine democratic discussion and participation. Both the ACF seminar and the Opinion Festival will be held in the small town of Paide in central Estonia.

#### **Objectives**

The main objective of the event is to promote networking and mutual learning by sharing best practices in citizen engagement and introducing the Opinion Festival format to all participating countries.
