Sažetak projekta:

Sustav podrške i pružanja usluga u zajednici destabiliziran je dugotrajnom krizom, pri čemu su osobito pogođene ranjive skupine. Istovremeno dolazi do jačanja građanske solidarnosti i promjene urbanih dinamika, s naglaskom na gradska naselja.

Projekt je usmjeren na jačanje kapaciteta lokalnih zajednica kroz razvoj modela suradnje građana i organizacija civilnog društva, s posebnim fokusom na kvartove. U okviru projekta uspostavljaju se 4 Centra zajednice u 3 gradske četvrti, koristeći infrastrukturu projektnih partnera. Ovi Centri će kroz umrežavanje OCD-a i aktivaciju građana jačati podršku za ranjive skupine poput LGBTIQ+ osoba, mladih i starijih.

Suradnja s norveškim partnerom omogućit će primjenu uspješnih inozemnih praksi rada u zajednici. Razvijeni model Centara zajednice planira se replicirati u 8 mjesnih odbora i osigurati održivost uključivanjem gradskih vlasti. Daljnje širenje Mreže planirano je i za područje Brezovice.

Project summary:

The community support and service delivery system has been destabilized by the prolonged crisis, disproportionately affecting vulnerable groups. Simultaneously, there is a growing wave of citizen solidarity and a shift in urban dynamics focusing on urban neighbourhoods. The project aims to strengthen local community capacities by developing a collaboration model between citizens and civil society organizations, with a specific focus on neighbourhoods. Four Community Centers are being established in three city districts using the infrastructure of project partners. These Centers will enhance support for vulnerable groups such as LGBTIQ+ individuals, youth, and the elderly through networking of CSOs and citizen activation. Collaboration with a Norwegian partner will facilitate the adoption of successful international community work practices. The developed Community Centers model will be replicated in 8 local committees and ensure sustainability through engagement with city authorities. Future expansion of the Network is planned for the Brezovica area.
